

**SHARPSBURG MAYOR AND COUNCIL
SPECIAL SESSION
SEPTEMBER 29, 2025**

The Mayor and Council of Sharpsburg, MD held a special session on Monday, September 29, 2025 at 6:00 P.M. in the Council meeting room of Town Hall located at 106 E. Main Street in Sharpsburg. In attendance were Mayor Russell Weaver, Vice Mayor Jacob Martz, Councilmembers Joe Kudla and Heather Waters. Town Administrator Debra Valentine-Smith was also present.

Mayor Weaver called the special session to order and asked Councilmember Kudla to lead the pledge.

COUNCIL VACANCIES

Town Administrator Valentine-Smith stated that applications were being accepted for two-(2) vacant council seats on July 14,2025 through August 15, 2025. Two-(2) applications were received; from former Council member Robbie Waters and from Anne-Marie McCullough.

Council was asked they had reviewed the applications and a recommendation for approval for appointment was requested for each person.

Motion by Councilmember Kudla, second by Vice-Mayor Martz to appoint Robbie Waters to complete the un-expired term until 2026. Motion carried with Councilmember Heather Waters abstaining.

Motion by Vice-Mayor Martz, second by Councilmember Kudla to appoint Anne-Marie McCullough to complete the un-expired term until 2028. Motion carried.

SWEARING IN OF NEWLY APPOINTED OFFICIALS – Mayor Weaver officially presented the Oath of Office to newly appointed Councilmembers R. Waters and McCullough as required under Article 12. General Provisions, Section 1201of the Town Charter.
